The Logue Papers are contained in three boxes arranged among sixty-five folders, which fall into the following categories: Williamsport High School, Bucknell University, Roosevelt Junior High School, Wine, Theater, Travel, Williamsport Area Community College (W.A.C.C.) and Pennsylvania College of Technology. Examples of the above collections are: course materials from his junior and senior years as a student at the Williamsport High School; course materials from his undergraduate days at Bucknell University; materials documenting his involvement with the Bucknell Alumni Association and the Bucknell Association for the Arts; yearbooks and other publications from his career as an English teacher at Roosevelt Junior High School; a collection of wine labels; W.A.C.C. Cinema Club posters and articles, newspaper clippings and slides of his European travels.

As both a student and teacher of wine appreciation, he accumulated brochures, clippings, articles, notes on wine, particularly Tuscan wines, as well as a collection of wine labels. His interest in and pursuit of travel is reflected by an extensive collection of articles and clippings on travel in Western Europe. Mr. Logue's files from the Williamsport Area Community College include his paper "The Blonde Madonna," in which he explored the pre-Reformation depiction in paintings of the Madonna and other 'good' women. Of interest is his file of newspaper clippings on the local textbook controversy surrounding the college's use of the text *Confrontation: Issues of the Seventies*. Issues of *Time*, *Saturday Review* and *Humanities, Art & Man* reflect his research and teaching interests. Photos of the 1977 W.A.C.C. Spring Recognition Banquet are also included. The game "Settle or Strike, a Union-Management Collective Bargaining Simulation Exercise," circa 1974.

Pennsylvania College of Technology materials include documents of the President's Quality Commission ("Q" Commission,) 1993-1997. A file of correspondence spanning the years 1970 through 2000 completes the collection.
