It is a suggested sequence for facilitation of advising communication based upon the student's academic profile, which will be provided after official evaluation of all transfer credit. The academic profile will determine transfer of credits and graduation requirements.

## **Additional Transfer Information**

- Applicants must have a final cumulative GPA of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher. Accreditation or discipline requirements may require that all courses eligible for transfer be completed with a "C" or higher.
- Students must complete a minimum of 36 credits at Pennsylvania College of Technology for coursework prescribed in the final four semesters of the student's baccalaureate profile.
- Individuals must submit a completed Application for Admission. Application fees are waived when submitted online. Paper applications will require a \$50 nonrefundable fee.
- Applicant must provide an *official* transcript of all college course work.
- Students transferring to Pennsylvania College of Technology are eligible and will be considered for scholarship opportunities the same as currently enrolled students. Students must meet the application deadlines for scholarships for the fall and spring enrollment. Student must have paid tuition deposit to be eligible.
- Students must request transcripts from additional institutions to be evaluated on an individual basis at Pennsylvania College of Technology.
